My Background

With over 20 years in IT and a strong foundation in Windows, Citrix, and VMware system administration, I've delivered results in logistics, mining, brewing, aviation, banking, insurance, and retail. Over a decade ago, I moved into project management, combining deep technical fluency with strategic oversight to lead high-impact transformation and infrastructure initiatives.
